[Costs of Care](#), in partnership with the [ABIM Foundation](#), is excited to offer a one-year [Teaching Value in Healthcare Learning Network](#) Fellowship (July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019) to recent graduates of residency programs, fellowship programs, or advanced practice nursing programs, as well as chief residents, in any specialty or discipline, who want to work with national leaders in promoting discussion, training, and dissemination efforts in improving the delivery of value-based healthcare.

Fellows can look forward to entering a national network of key stakeholders in the field, including frontline clinicians, medical educators, and health systems leaders. Fellows will lead the Learning Network under the guidance of Costs of Care's Director of Outreach and Evaluation, Dr. Reshma Gupta, and help to guide strategy and implementation of key national Costs of Care initiatives throughout the year. The Fellow will have the opportunity to collaborate on a publication and receive mentorship from our expert [Costs of Care Directors](#).

Candidates:

If able (i.e. not governmental employment, etc), the Fellow will be offered a financial stipend (not to exceed \$5,000 for the year) to support the Fellow to attend conferences and other professional development activities approved by the Costs of Care Director of Outreach and Evaluation and the Costs of Care Director of Operations.

The chosen Fellow will be formally announced via a social media campaign spearheaded by the Costs of Care team.

Learning Network Fellowship:

The Fellowship is designed to be accommodate your professional interests and ideas.

Responsibilities include:

- Dedicate 5-10 hours each month to the Fellowship
- Co-manage strategy with the Costs of Care Director of Outreach and Evaluation: including, but not limited to, redesigning discussion board to promote optimal activity,



bringing new ideas to the webinar/podcast format, and identifying a key improvement/initiative for the network for the year

- Identify and formulate inclusion strategies for diverse specialties and health systems
- Oversee, in collaboration with the Costs of Care Director of Outreach and Evaluation, our vast network of monthly webinar speakers and moderators.

Benefits to Fellow:

- Mentorship in value-based healthcare from the Costs of Care Directors, who are spread across 4 regions of the country and maintain roles in research and publishing, management, leadership, education, and policy
