Overview:

[Costs of Care](#) is excited to offer a one-year Costs of Care Fellowship (July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020) to chief residents and/or recent graduates of residency programs, fellowship programs, or advanced practice nursing programs, in any specialty or discipline, who want to work with national leaders in promoting discussion, training, and dissemination efforts to improve the delivery of value-based healthcare.

The Costs of Care Fellow can look forward to entering a national network of key stakeholders in the field, including clinicians, medical educators, and health systems leaders, and expect to:

- receive mentorship in value-based healthcare from the Costs of Care Directors, who are spread across 4 regions of the country and maintain roles in research and publishing, management, leadership, education, and policy;
- expand skills in NGO operations, writing, publishing, presenting, online and social media presence, and relationship building with frontline clinicians, medical educators and health systems leaders;
- utilize the title of Fellow and their role as part of an influential, national healthcare non-profit for their resume and/or interviews.

The Fellowship is designed to accommodate your professional interests and ideas.

Responsibilities include:

- dedicating 5-10 hours each month to the Fellowship;
- co-managing the strategy of the upcoming InnoVATE platform with the Costs of Care Directors: including, but not limited to, designing a key improvement/initiative for the InnoVATE platform and formulating inclusion strategies for engaging diverse specialties, disciplines, and health systems;
- maintaining social media communications via Twitter.

Candidates:

If able (i.e. not governmental employment, etc.), the Fellow will be offered a financial stipend (not to exceed \$5,000 for the year) to support the Fellow in attending conferences and/or other professional development activities approved by the Costs of Care Directors.

The chosen Fellow will be formally announced via a social media campaign spearheaded by the Costs of Care team.
